Click on the hyper link or press ctrl and click on the image to be taken to a YouTube audio book.

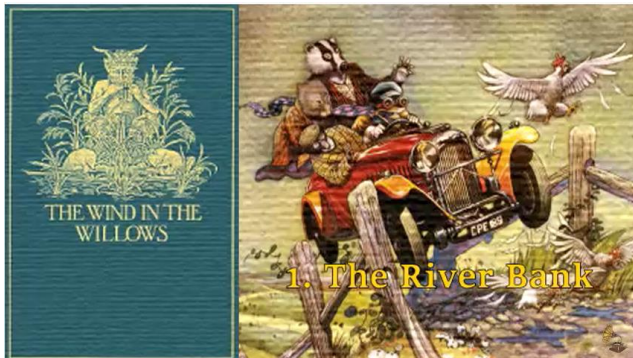
You can follow the story by opening one of the Word documents which your form teacher has posted in TEAMS, which have the full text for each book.

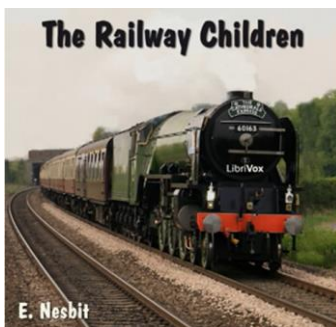

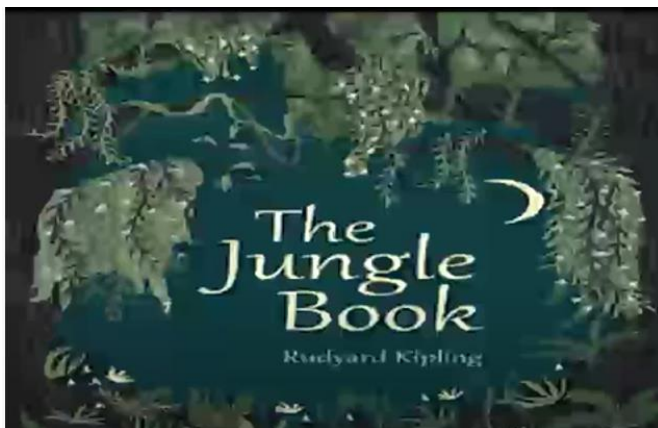

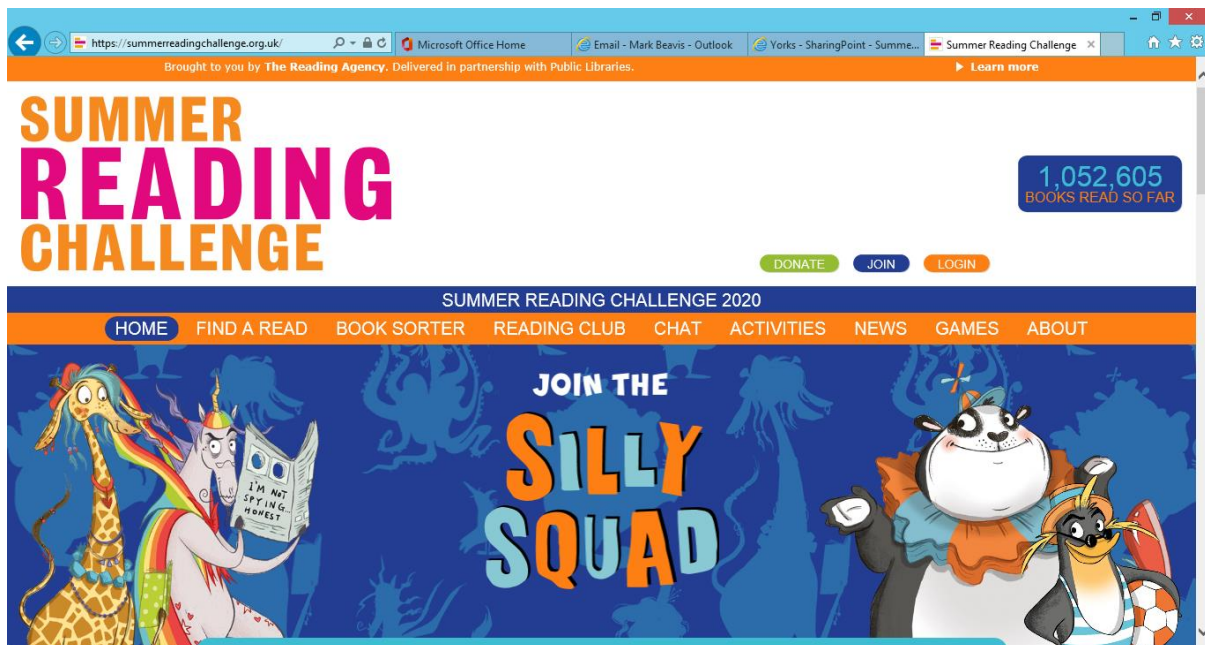
