Dear Parents, Carers and Pupils,

Returning to School

As you will have seen, the government has announced that it hopes to re-open primary schools, beginning with Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 pupils after half term.

Although there is a lot of speculation in the media about what MIGHT happen in secondary schools before the end of Summer term, particularly with the current Y10 and Y12 pupils, there is no plan at this time for the return of secondary school pupils. If this position changes over the coming weeks we will ensure that we communicate any planning to you in advance.

Leaders in the school continue to work on ensuring that when pupils do return, it will be to safe, clean environments in which whatever social distancing measures recommended by the government can be implemented.

I would like to thank everyone – staff, parents and pupils – for the ways in which we have united across the school in responding to the situation so far and have ensured that our pupils have continued to learn from home. This has taken a great deal of time, effort, energy and patience on everyone's part, but we should be proud of what is being achieved.

I know that the current Year 11 and Year 13 pupils will be particularly anxious about the future and we will be making additional resources and support available over the final half term of the year to make sure that their progression into VI Form, Further and Higher Education is supported. We are also working very closely with primary schools to make sure that the Year 6 pupils who would normally be joining us as 'early risers' in a few weeks' time are welcomed into the school 'virtually'. As plans for schools returning become clearer, we plan to supplement this with some activities for them on-site, although we do recognise that it might be late August or early September by the time this can happen.

We will, of course, be continuing to operate our online learning programme, which can be accessed at https://www.sheffieldpark-academy.org/learning-from-home. After half-term, there will be an increase in 'online teaching' and video lessons as we recognise the need to provide more bespoke learning and support for pupils' progress.

We have managed to secure funding for the next tranche of Chromebooks to go out to those students who will benefit from them most and are working to extend this offer further. It will be important for us to continue to offer online learning programmes long after all pupils return to school as it is vital that the learning gaps that will have opened up can be addressed. All of us look forward to welcoming pupils back to school as soon as is safely possible. In the meantime, please keep safe and well, encourage your children to continue to participate in their online learning and keep following the government advice as it evolves.
