### **End of Term Arrangements**

The Academy will close to students at 1:30pm (end of period 4) on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December for the start of the Christmas holidays. There will be a lot of rewards and attendance prizes being awarded on this day - be there so you don't miss out!

The academy will re-open to students on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2026, at the normal time.



When we re-open to students on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2026, a reminder that all students must:

- Come to school by 8:35am (any student arriving after 8:40am is late)
- Arrive in full school uniform
- Bring their full set of equipment a fully stocked pencil case, school planner and school timetable.

#### **Year 11 Mock 1 Results**

Year 11s received their Mock 1 results on Wednesday this week: congratulations to those students who were happy with their progress so far, we are incredibly proud of how hard the vast, vast majority of our students have worked. *What to do next?* 

- All Year 11s need to be attending after school 'Success Sessions' if they attend these, they will get better grades.
- All Year 11s need to attend Saturday sessions (when invited) if they attend these, they will get better grades.
- All Year 11s need to attend holiday sessions if they attend these, they will get better grades.

For students not yet getting at least a grade 4 in mathematics and at least one of their English GCSEs, will need to work hard to gain a grade 4 or above. Students who do not attain grade 4 or above in mathematics and one English GCSE must re-sit these at Post-16 and we do not want this for them.



We believe this Year 11 cohort has the ability to be the highest achieving Year 11 cohort at SPA for a number of years, but they must work hard and not give up. Year 11 is tough, but so are the students.

## **Christmas Jumper Day!**

Friday 19 December is Christmas Jumper Day 2025 at SPA!

On this day, all students can choose to wear a Christmas Jumper in replacement of either their school jumper or school blazer.



We will be asking for donations to a local charity on this day as part of our academy value of 'community'. It is important to note that this is not a non-uniform day: only a Christmas Jumper is permitted as different to the normal school uniform.

# **Christmas Academy Day - Friday 12th December**

On Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December we will be hosting Christmas Dinner for all students. This will be an extended lunch break (with year groups attending on a staggered timetable) to ensure everyone can eat a Christmas Dinner, if they wish to.

Students can opt to sit in the main dining hall for this event or to get their Christmas Dinner from one of our outdoor catering pods. As you will be aware, our dining space is small, but we are in the process of applying to build an extension to this in the next 12-18 months to solve this.
